## Part 3 - Voting WAX on Bloks.io



Once you've successfully logged into the wax.bloks.io website you can easily vote. To maintain the highest possible vote strength, you must vote every 7 days or less. ## Voting Individual Block Producers

Step 1 - Click on the "Vote" region on the top navigation bar (also known as the nav bar)

You have 2 options for voting. You can vote for individual block producers or select a proxy to do the voting for you. With either selection you need to come back every 7 days or less and cast your vote(s).

Step 2 - Voting for "Block Producers" is automatically selected when you reach the voting page . Click on the check box next to at least 16 block producers.

Step 3 - Click the Vote button


Step 4 - Approve your votes via Scatter wallet or Ledger Nano S/X. One issue that you will notice on the ledger is that you need to approve every block producer. If you select 30 block producers, you will need to approve all 30 on your Ledger. This is one reason why the binjteamwax1 proxy was created. See below for more information on proxy voting.

## Proxy Voting

Step 1 - Click on the "Vote" region on the top navigation bar (also known as the nav bar)

Step 2 - Click on the "Proxies" region on the secondary top navigation bar

Step 3 - Select the Proxy you wish to use. It is recommended you use "binjteamwax1", but use whatever you'd like.

Step 4 - Click the "SET <proxy name> AS PROXY" button.


Step 5 - Approve your votes via Scatter wallet or Ledger Nano S/X.
